
INSTRUCTIONS:


In 1839, Tom Sprague set a wood post with the following B.T.'s: Elm, 12", S.35°W., 29 links (19.14 feet); Birch, 12", N.40°W., 21 links (13.86 feet).

In 1935, F. P. Gould, Deputy Surveyor, Marinette County set 4" pipe with a stamped brass cap to identify the corner.

In 1976, William Cochrane (R.L.S.) found monument in place. Set the following B.T.'s: White Spruce, 8", N.50°W., 7.81 feet; White Spruce, 8", S.59°W., 5.81 feet; Steel Sign Post, Southeast, 0.50 feet.

In 1990, Alan Harrison (R.L.S.) found monument inplace, andded new B.T.'s.
