

November/2001 — Jeffrey K. Inman, R.L.S. S—1676, recovered a 1" iron pipe. He does not indicate any new ties to the 1" iron pipe. The pipe recovered is shown on the right—of—way plat of County Trunk Highway "B".

December/2003 — Matthew E. Hoglund found and accepted a 1" iron pipe as the East 1/4 comer of Section 18. We set 4 new ties to the Iron pipe as shown below.



IRON PIPE FOUND


