1859 — James McBride, set original corner post and made the following B.T.'s: Birch, 6", N 14° E, 27 lks., 17.82 feet.

Birch, 6", N 48° W, 14 lks., 9.24 feet.

2001 — I found no evidence of the original corner. I found remains of a cedar fence post at the intersection of fence lines running South & East. I thus accepted the cedar post and fence line intersection as the best possible evidence of the corner position. I replaced post with a Forest County aluminum monument and made 4 new B.T.'s described below.






Set Forest County
