Corner restored by H.C. Lawrence, Registered Land Surveyor, in 1950. Recovered OBT's: White pine stump S40°W 30 links

White pine stump N25°E 18 links, with scribe marks.

Set new post from these BT's. A balsam 18" had been marked for BT but no notes were available for it. Rescribed balsam S16°E, 20 links.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 5" tamarack post, squared and scribed S13 R11E, S24 T36N, S19, S18 R12E, in fair condition.

Recovered OBT's: Original white pine 12" S40°W 31 links - now a decayed stump. S16°E 20 links - scribing rotted out. Balsam 18"

Replaced tamarack post with 2-1/2" Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument. Aluminum with magnet installed in cap and base, projecting 6" above ground, cap stamped -S498 T36N 11 13 18 12 E 24 19 E
