1919 — I.R. Ritter set an iron pipe at quarter corner position and made the following B.T.'s:

Hemlock, 12", N 05" E, 23 lks., 15.18 feet.

Hemlock, 20", S 32" W, 8 lks., 5.28 feet.

2008 — I found a 1 1/4" iron pipe from 1919 Ritter Survey in excellent condition.

I found B.T.'s from 1919 Survey, now rotted stumps.

I made the following new B.T.'s to iron pipe:

Hemlock, 25", S 53° E, 22.06 feet. Cedar, 12", S 06° E, 23.81 feet. Sugar, 12", N 43° W, 9.53 feet. Cedar, 9", N 09° E, 23.04 feet.





Note: All distances are taken to nail in side of tree.


