

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established by James McBride, Deputy Surveyor, in 1859 from which hemlock 10" bears N87°E, 34 links and hemlock 24" bears N49°W, 14 links.

This corner recovered by Connor Forest Industries surveyor and maintained by foresters for many years.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered old 3" squared hemlock stake and a 1-1/2" iron pipe.

No evidence of any OBT's visible.

Pipe post and BT's painted blue.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Replaced the 1-1/2" iron pipe, which appeared to be older than the hemlock stake, with 2-1/2" Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument, aluminum, with magnet installed in cap and base. Pipe projects 18" above ground. Set old iron pipe and squared hemlock beside it. Cap stamped -
