History of original corner establishment: Original corner established by James McBride, Deputy Surveyor, in 1859, from which elm 6" bears S47°E 23 links, and elm 8" bears N49°W 20 links. Ray Leigh, Consolidated Forester, recovered this corner in 1949, while cruising and mapping. No record of any previous surveys subsequent to the original. This corner was still intact in 1959 during a new cruise and mapping program.

Description of corner evidence found: Recovered large rock cairn with old hardwood stake in its center. No evidence of the original BT's or stake. Stanley Novack, retired forester, USFS, informed us that this point had been recognized as the & corner, substantiated by an old USFS location tag on 18" elm, marked S70°E 15 ft. Bearing check but distance is one link too short..

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Removed the rock cairn from around stake. The hole under cairn appeared to be much larger than hardwood post. Replaced it with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument, aluminum, with magnet installed in cap and base. Pipe projects 18" above ground level. Cap
