Description of corner evidence found:

No original corner evidence was recovered.

Found an old 4"x4" wood post lying on ground which was recovered by Milo Stefan RLS for the U.S. Forest Service on 6/24/81. I found wood post to be 4' North and 3' East of the proportioned corner position. No evidence of original bearing trees. Post is located on the North edge of a Red Pine plantation.

I set the corner position by single proportionate measurement and on line between the Northwest and Northeast Section corners of Section 10 because I felt it better represented the corner position than the wood post found lying on the ground.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the corner position, set a 2½ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 3 inches above the ground surface, with an aluminum cap stamped: T36N, R15E, 1/4, S-3, S-10, 1994, S-1634; from which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear: (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)


