Description of corner evidence found:

Found iron pipe and accepted as the best evidence of the corner location. The local residents have long accepted that location for the corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Set a 2 1/2" diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 2 feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T37N, R12E, 1/4, S9, S16, 1986, S-1165. Established the following new bearing trees which are blazed, scribed, painted and tagged. Aspen woods to the East and open field to the West of the monument. Monument placed in the East. West fence line.


