History of original corner establishment: Original corner established by James L. Nowlin, Gov. Deputy Surveyor, in 1865, from which Tamarack 10" bears N29°W 12 links, and Tamarack 10" bears S72°E 4 links.

Corner recovered by Ray Leigh, Consolidated Forester, who claims he found an old decayed post in place and set iron pipe in its place. P.T. Hansen, Registered Land Surveyor, perpetuated corner since 1948.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered Leigh's $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe in place. No BT's were recovered although extensive search was made for remains of old Tamarack BT's.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument, aluminum pipe with magnet installed in cap and base. Cap stamped - \$498 Pipe projects 6" above ground. Drove old iron pipe beside \$1737N R14E new post.

NBT's - Tamarack 7" S88^oW 40.5 links, scribed 表 BT.
Tamarack 9" N64^oE 35.5 links, scribed 表 BT.

Post and NBT's painted blue.
