




## U. S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

In 1859, James McBride set a wooden post and selected the following bearing trees: 5" S52°E Spruce 15 1ks. 5" S39°W Spruce 17 lks.

In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff established the corner and set a 2" dia. driveable aluminum Berntsen monument stamped to identify the corner. The following corner references: 4" SO9°E Tamarack 80.78 ft. Steel sign post 1.2 ft. West 5" N30°E Spruce 91.40 ft.

In 1990, John Schulke recovered monument in place and the monument is located in an open Recovered the following corner references: Spruce swamp. Spruce N30°E 91.40 ft. Steel sign post 1.2 ft. West Tamarack Sll°E 80.85 ft. The following new corner references:

Spruce • 3" s37°W 63.62 ft. 4" Spruce N20°E 86.30 ft.


