

 - In 1954, F.R. Wincentsen reestablished corner by proportionate measurement and set an iron pipe with brass cap stamped to identify the corner. Selected the following bearing trees; 5" NO5°E 37.8 1ks. Balsam Spruce 4" N87°E 46 1ks.
 - In 1973, Jean Resvick recovered hole where the monument had been set and the following bearing trees: Spruce NO5°E 25 ft. Balsam S87°E 30.4 ft. Set a 2" dia. galvanized iron pipe, filled with concrete, with a brass cap stamped to identify the corner. Recorded Certified Land Corner Restoration form filed in Forest Co. Register of Deed's Office, Document #104445.
 - In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff recovered monument in place and the following corner references; 5" N43°W 27.32 ft. Balsam Spruce 4" N37°W 30.40 ft. Set a steel sign post NW a distance of 1.0 ft. from the monument.
 - In 1990, John Schulke recovered monument in place and the following corner references; W. Spruce 6" N43°W 27.37 ft. 9" N05°E 24.99 ft. W. Spruce Dead Balsam 5" S86°E 30.5 ft. SSP NW 1.0 ft. The following new corner references: 7" S44°W Red Maple 33.61 ft.
