

## U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

(As Required by WI Adm. Code)

History of original corner establishment and subsequent restorations and descriptions of any record, monument, occupational, testimonial or other evidence considered:

1859 — James McBride, set quarter corner section post and made the following B.T.'s:

Spruce, 10", N 13" W, 27 lks., 17.82 feet.

Spruce, 8", N 42" E, 22 lks., 14.52 feet.

2003 — I found no evidence of the original corner or accessories.

I found a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe marking the quarter corner. I accepted the position of the Iron Pipe as the best possible evidence of the quarter corner and replaced with a Forest County Aluminum Pipe Monument.




