In 1929, Melindy, a Local Surveyor, sub-divided Section 18. At the corner position, he set a Cedar Post, from which a 48" Pine bears S53°W, 45.70 feet Description of corner evidence found:

Found $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter iron pipe, from which a pine stump bears S53°W, 45.70 feet.

I accept the iron pipe in concurrence with bearing tree evidence as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

No original corner evidence was recovered.


