W. Pine 10" N10°W 11 1ks. Aspen 8" S08°E 9 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was recovered.

I re-established the corner position at mid-point and on line between the Southwest and Southeast Section Corners of Section 14.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. At the corner position, set a 1 inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 5 feet long, 5 feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T40N R13E, 1/4, S14, S23, 1991, S-1107. 
