

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. West corrected between Sections 12 and 13, 40.33 chains, set Quarter Section Post to Sections 12 ans 13, from which the following bear;

Sugar	12"	N30°E	10	lks.
Cedar	10"	S46°W	14	lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was recovered.

The corner position is re-established at proportionate distance and on line between the Southeast and Southwest Section Corners of Section 12.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the corner position, set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T40N R14E, 1/4, S12, S13, 1986, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;




