## SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, John H. Fisher, Registered Land Surveyor No. S-836 hereby certify that we have surveyed the property described below; that this plat is an accurate survey and a true representation thereof and correctly shows the exterior boundary lines and the correct measurements thereof; that we have made such survey by order of NEIL SCHALLOCK, and that we have complied with Chapter 236.34 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

OUTLOTS 1, 2, 3 and 4 being part of Gov't Lot 5, Section 31, T35N, R13E, Nashville Township, Forest County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner common to Sections 31 and 6, marked by an iron pipe; thence S89°-43.4'W, 654.11 feet along the section line to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe on the westerly edge of a 66 foot wide easement road.

Thence continuing S89°-43.4'W, 570.05 feet along the section line to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Little Sand Lake; thence along the lake N42°-17.9'E, 247.52 feet, N33°-38.0'E, 125.00 feet, N32°-46.7'E, 114.86 feet and N23°-46.0'E, 115.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence S61°-02.0'E, 466.81 feet to an iron pipe on the westerly edge of a 66 foot wide easement road; thence S35°-05.0'W, 317.90 feet along the westerly edge of a 66 foot wide easement road to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and shore of Little Sand Lake.
