

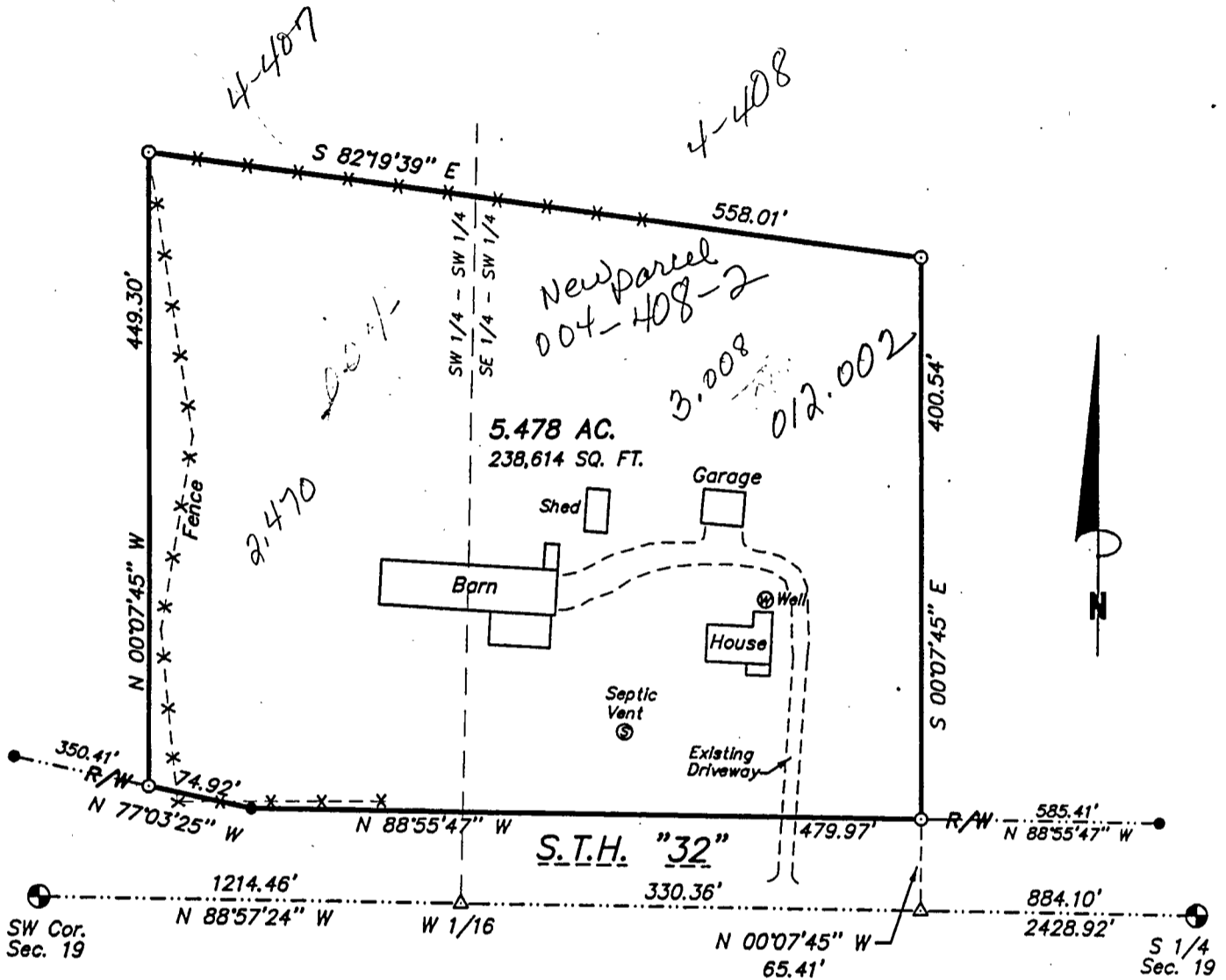

PLAT OF SURVEY

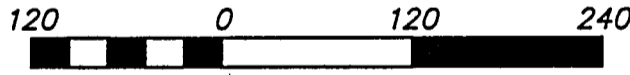

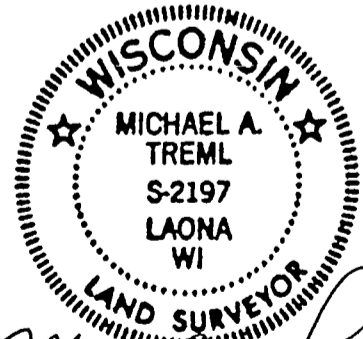

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Part of the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) & Part of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Thirty-seven North (T37N), Range Thirteen East (R13E), Town of Argonne, Forest County, Wisconsin being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the South Quarter corner of said Section 19; thence N 88°57'24" W along the South line of said SW ¼, a distance of 884.10 feet; thence N 00°07'45" W, a distance of 65.41 feet to the Northerly right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway 32 (S.T.H. "32") and the **POINT OF BEGINNING**; thence N 88°55'47" W along said right-of-way line, a distance of 479.97 feet; thence N 77°03'25" W along said right-of-way line, a distance of 74.92 feet; thence N 00°07'45" W, a distance of 449.30 feet; thence S 82°19'39" E, a distance of 558.01 feet; thence S 00°07'45" E, a distance of 400.54 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, and containing 5.478 acres.
