

- 2 inch 1.D. iron pipe monument with a brass cap set by General Land Office Dependent 1924 Resurvey.
- 1 inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 36 inches long with an aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner.
- \circ 2½ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 36 inches long set by Gary L. Pisoni in 1986.
- Boundary line marked to Forest Service standards.

NOTE: Bearings are true bearings referenced to the West, North 1/2 mile of Section 10 as determined by William Cochrane's plat of survey of 1984

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SURVEY NOTES

This survey was made by Gary L. Pisoni, a Registered Land Surveyor in the State of Wisconsin, for the U.S.D.A., Forest Service, for the purpose of recovering, restoring, establishing, marking, and perpetuating the corners and boundary lines of U.S. Government Land on the perimeter and within Section 9, Township 40 North, Range 14 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, Forest County Sate of Wisconsin, as shown on the plat map herewith.

The Original Government Sub-division of this township was done in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. The corners recovered by Jean Resvick and William Cochrane, Cadastral Surveyors for the U.S. Forest Service in 1968, 1972, and 1984, and the corners recovered by Dependent Resurvey in 1924 marking the perimeter of Section 9, were used as control for the sub-division survey of Section 9, also the South quarter corner was restored by Gary L. Pisoni RLS in 1986 from a survey of Section 16.

The bearings between corner positions are true bearings referenced to the true line bearing of the North Half of the West Section Line of Section 10 as determined by William B. Cochrane survey of 1984.

The accuracy of this survey exceeds the State requirements of 1 in 3000.

The field notes and a copy of the Plat of Survey are on file in the Forest Supervisor's Office at Rhinelander, Wisconsin.

The U.S. Government acquired title to the lands in Section 9 in 1935.
