## Surveyors Certificate

I W.L. Harris Surveyor do hereby certify that by order and direction of W.D. Connor and in full compliance with Chapter 101 revised Statutes of 1878 I have surveyed and mapped a part of the North east 1/4 of North W 1/4 of Section 31, T. 36, N. R. 15, E described as follows: Starting at a point on the south side of Mill street and the east line of Forest Ave 60 ft east of the north east corner of Lot 1, Blk. 12. 2<sup>nd</sup> By addition to the village of Laona, said point place of starting. Thence running south along the east side of Forest Ave to a point 660 ft from starting point. Thence east parallel to the south line of Mill Street a distance of 628.5 ft. Thence north parallel to the east line of Forest a distance of 660 ft and on the south line of Mill Street. Thence West on south line of Mill street a distance of 628.5 ft to the place of starting survey. The accompanying map and notes is a correct representation of all the exterior boundaries of the lands above described and the subdivisions therein made. The figures at or near center of each lot denotes the number of the lot. The figures along the lines denotes the length of lines in feet.

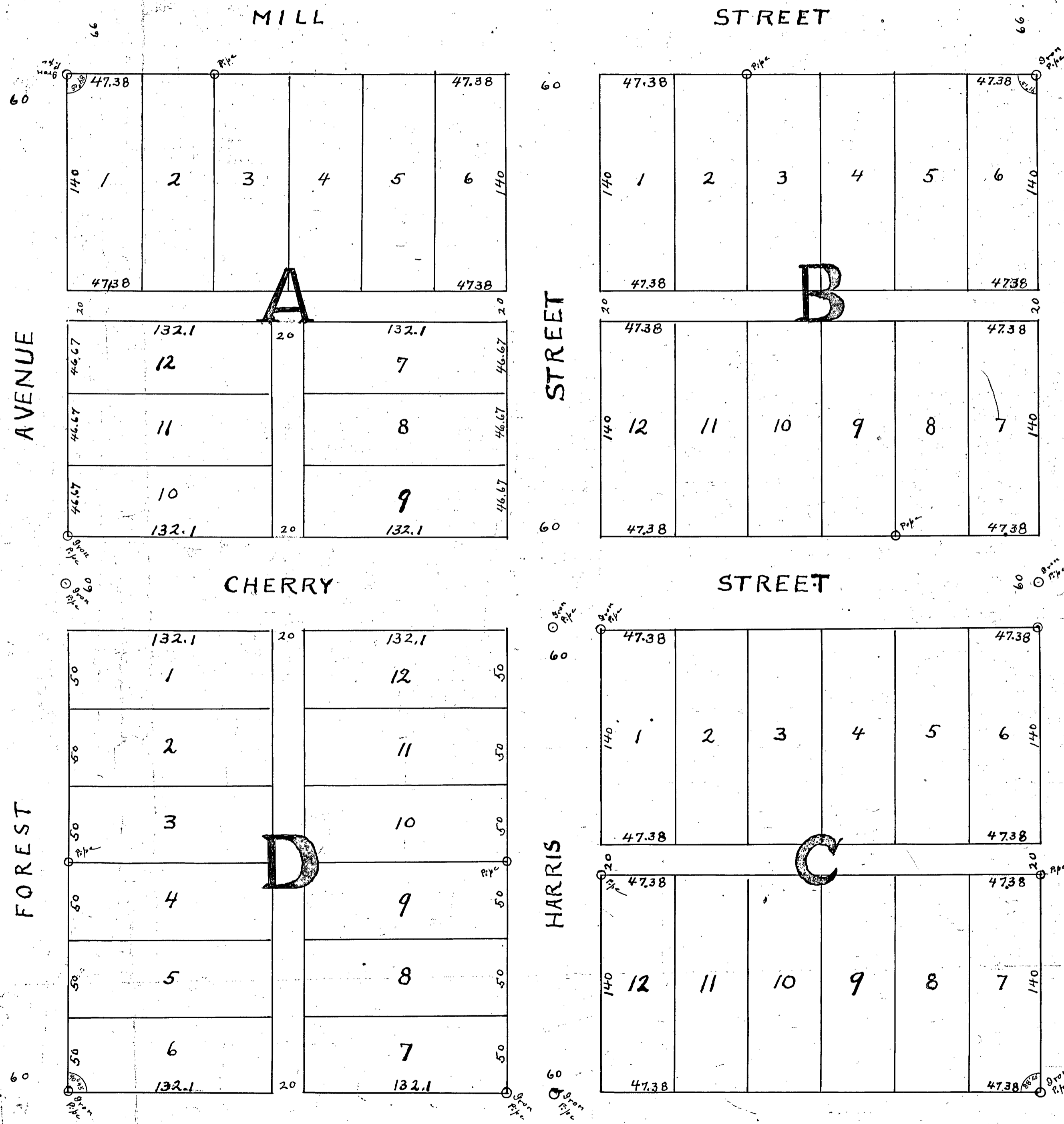
