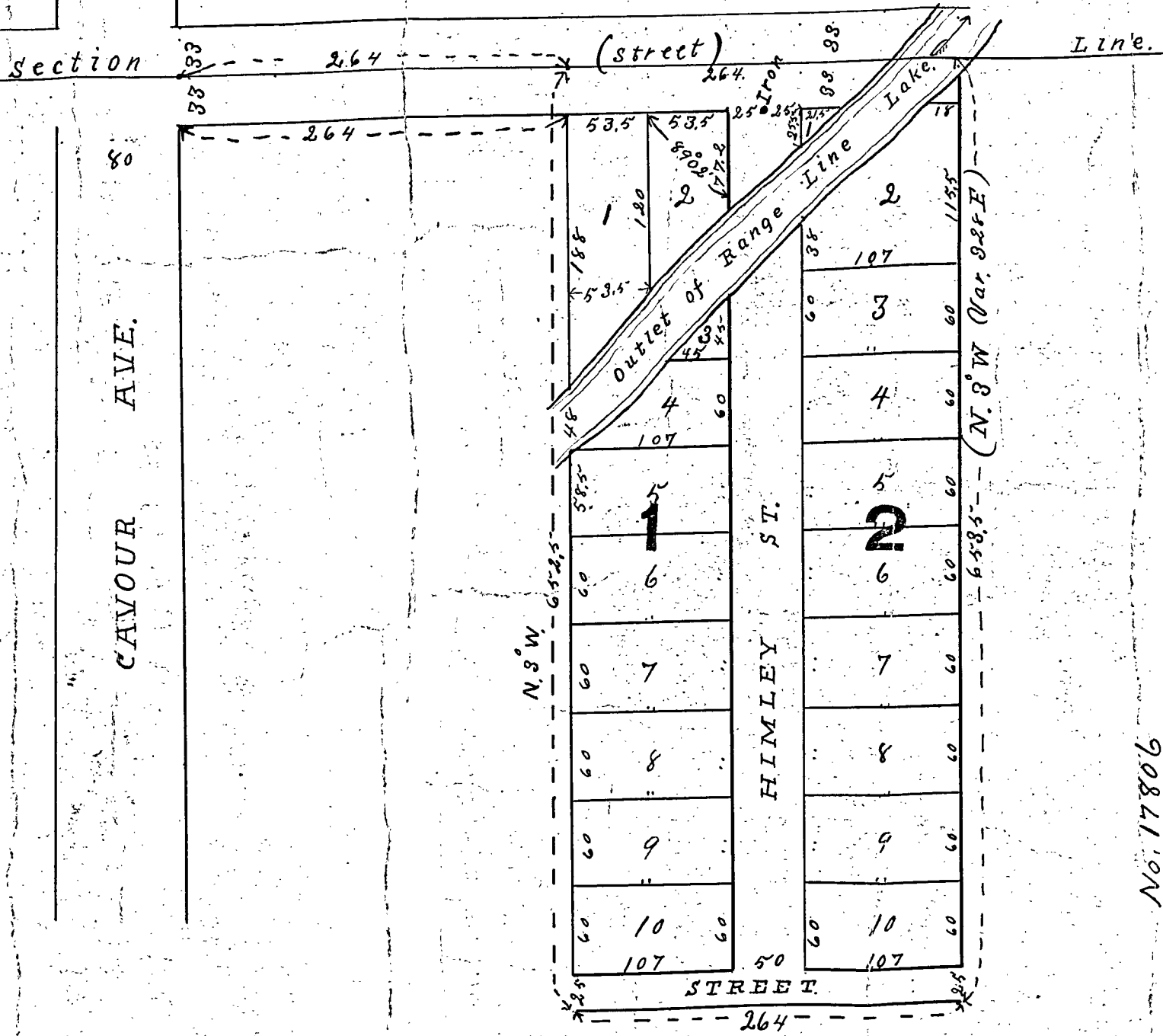

# Surveyor's Certificate

I, N. H. Smith surveyor do hereby Certify that I have surveyed and mapped into lots, blocks and streets all of that part of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 18 Township Co. 34 N.R. Co 15 E, that is bounded by the following described line. Commencing at a point on the North line of section 18 of the above named town and range 264 feet east of the east line of Gavour Avenue, thence running south 3 degrees east 652 1/2 feet, thence running east 264 feet, thence running north 3 degrees west 653 1/2 feet to the section line, thence east on section line 264 feet to place of beginning, that I made such survey and map by the order and direction of C. G. Kimbley the said owner, that said map is a true and correct representation of all of the exterior boundaries of the land surveyed and of the division thereon made, that in surveying subdividing and mapping the same I have fully complied with the provisions of Chapter 101 of the Revised Statute of 1898.

## Explanation

Wood stakes were driven at all corners. Corner on my transit adjusted at 3° 28' E. while running boundary. The above described land was laid into a 4 acre lot by the R.M. Co., and the corner stakes were all set at the time that survey was made. I. H. was a little short north and south according to my measure but left the corners where they were originally set.
