Woodbury and B. McGinley, surveyors, to be surveyed and mapped as represented on the within map. We, Samuel Shaw and Louise W. Shaw, his wife, further certify that we are the sole and exclusive owners, in fee simple, of all the lands in the Public Park of such plat, and we hereby dedicate to public use said lands of such park, for park purposes only, with the express stipulation, reservation and restriction that all the standing and growing timber on such park shall be permanently preserved, that said park shall not be made a dumping ground for rubbish of any kind, and that said park shall within a period of five (5) years from date hereof, be adopted and utilized for park purposes, by some legally qualified person, and that in the event the foregoing stipulations, reservation and restriction, it is hereby formally declared, by us to be our intent, that, in case of the breach of any of the foregoing conditions fully set out, the lands of said public park shall at once revert to us, our heirs, assigns, executors or administrators.

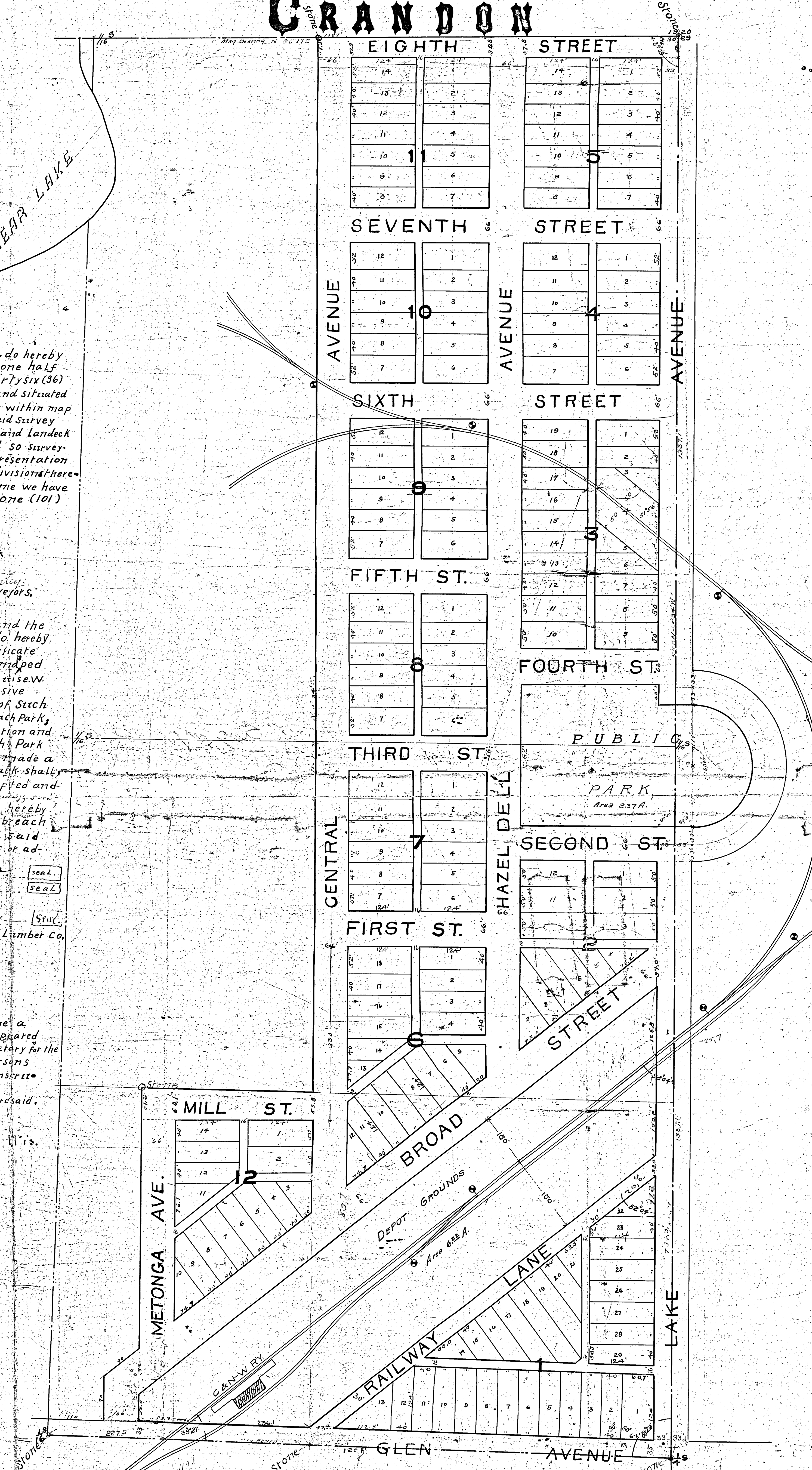
