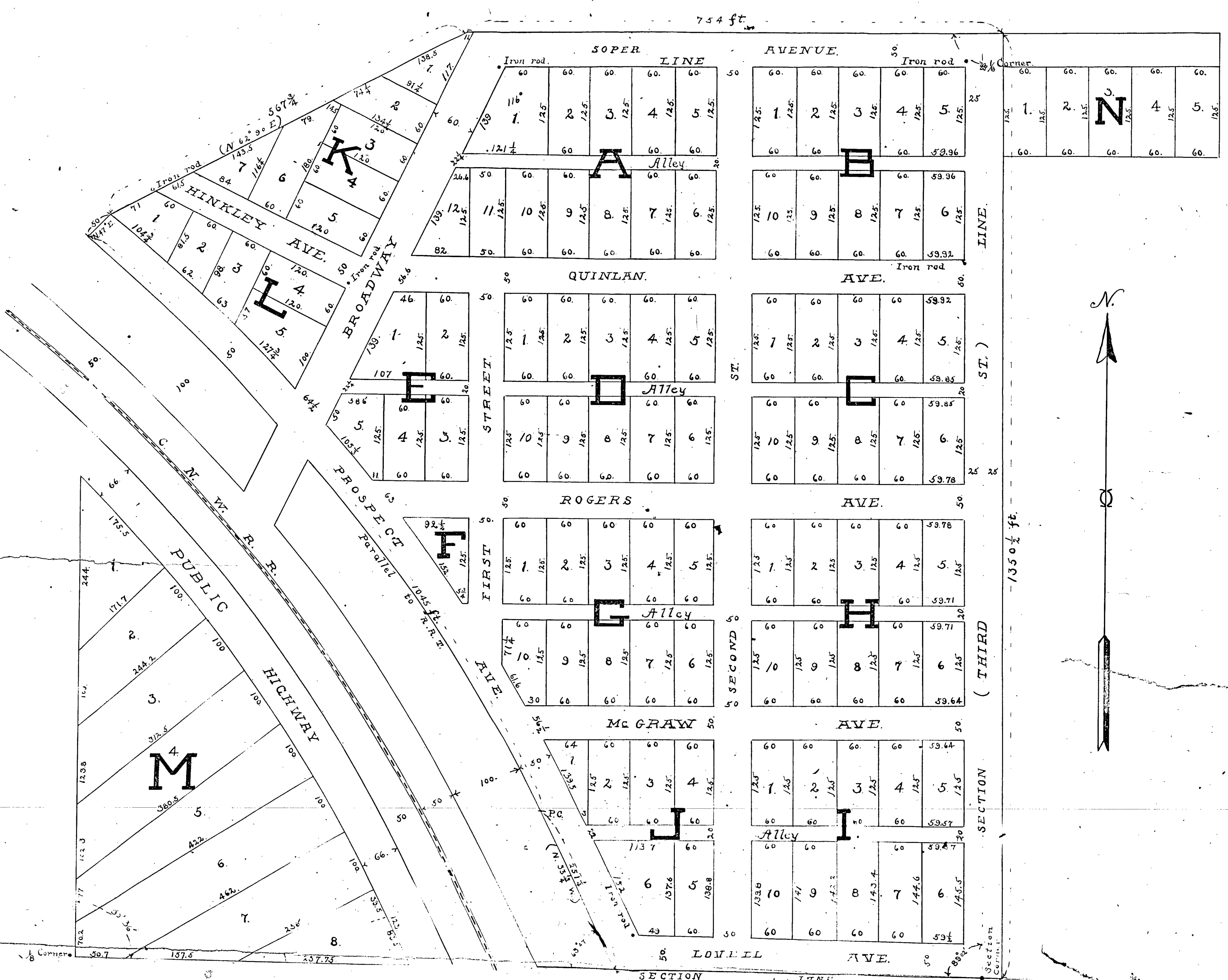


# SOPERTON,

PART OF THE EAST  $\frac{1}{2}$  OF THE SOUTHEAST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION No. 8 AND PART OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTH WEST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 9, T. No. 34, R. No. 15 E. SCALE OF PLAT IS 100 FEET PER INCH, AT POINTS MARKED ROUND DOTS IRON STAKES WERE SET ON THE PROLONGATION OF STREET LINES 2 FEET FROM CORNERS. CEDAR STAKES WERE DRIVEN AT ALL CORNERS.
