

A-E 7.08(3)(c)(d) Plan view of corner with references to at least 4 witness monuments.




A-E 7.08(3)(e) 1978 Surveyor restored the corner, 1982 Surveyor found a brass cap buried in road, 1985 Surveyor found a 2" brass capped monument. Between June 2001 and March 2002, Surveyors found a 3/4" iron rod (or rebar), as did I in 2024.
