

## THENCE:

- May 26, 1983 Cadastral Surveyor Richard J. Widmar prepared a "Corrective Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of Subdivisional Lines, Township 35 North, Range 12 East, indicates this position as "point for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 32 & 33, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. cor.; not monumented."
- July 28, 2008 Surveyor 2517 Charley G. Brinkmeier indicates this position as "set 2" I pipe" on Certified Survey Map #198250.
- April 3, 2023 Surveyor 3032 Michael J. Hoffman indicates this position as "found 2" iron pipe" on Certified Survey Map #239927.

January 9, 2025 - I found a 2" diameter iron pipe monument. The monument is on high ground in an open field and is ±8 below grade grade. I also found two 0.75" diameter iron pipe witnesses to the monument and a Vinyl T-Post. I established 2 new reference monuments as shown below.
