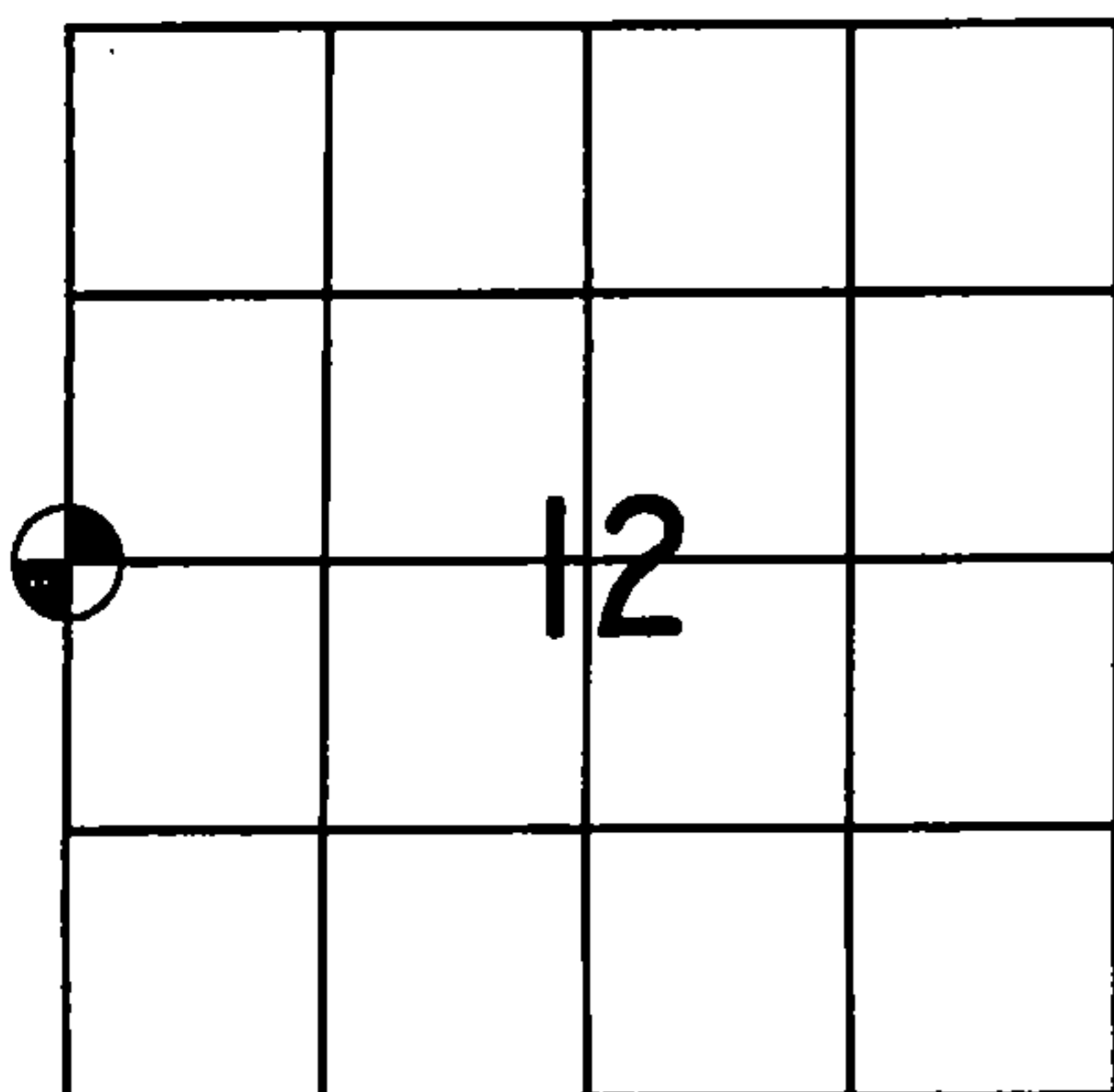

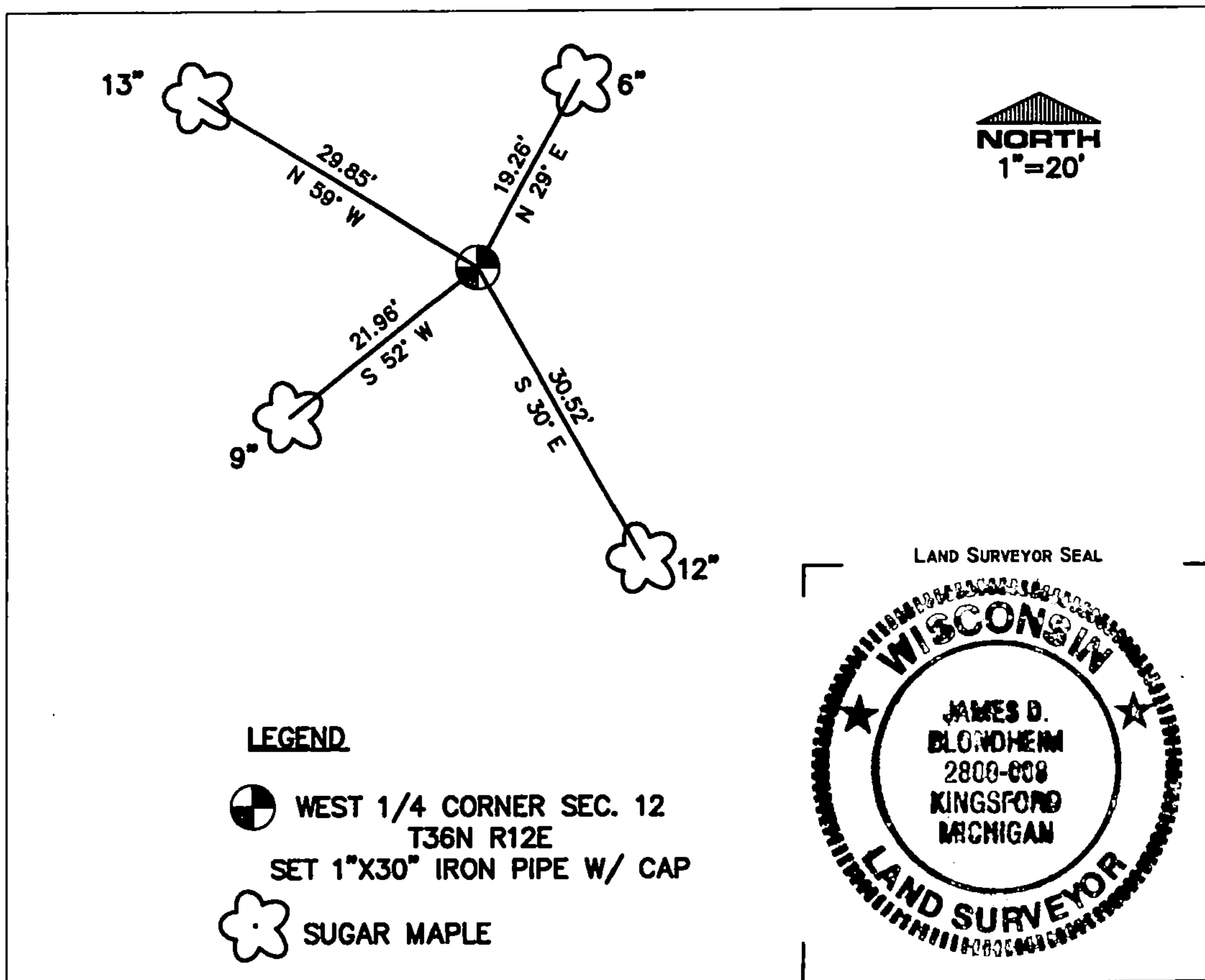

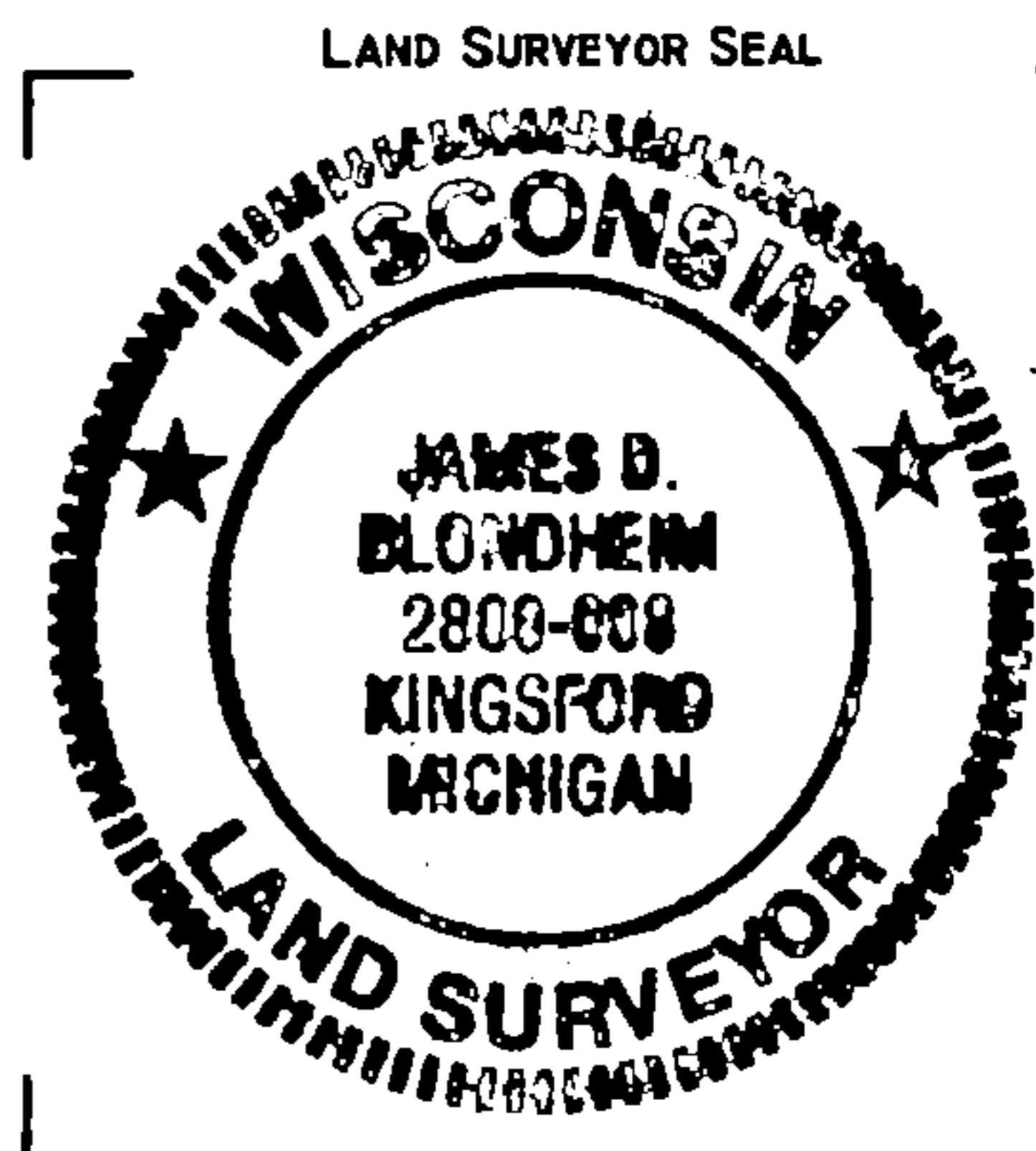


= LOCATION OF CORNER
