Dear Dan & Robin,

Enclosed you will find a map that I created as the result of survey work along your north property line at St. Johns Lake in the Town of Nashville, Forest County, WI. The map shows the location of steel fence posts set along the line.

While I was on this project and reviewing your deed, I find that an existing map of survey dated May 16, 2001, by surveyor Michael Treml, showing your neighbors (Dennis Klapper) property, also shows a dashed line around your property. I've enclosed a copy of the Treml survey map and the dashed line with "Vol. 229 Pg. 445" appears to be an accurate representation of your property lines. I have not located this line on the ground to check for encroachments or other problems. As you suspected and my computations confirm, your property appears to encompass 3.8 acres. The amount of right-of-way of CTH "Q" that is within your description could only be determined by survey and that would be deducted from the 3.8 acres. I don't know how Forest County came up with your acreage as being 15 acres shown on your tax bill, but I am sure that number is wrong. As you requested, I am sending a copy of these maps and this letter to the Forest County Property lister so that they can advise the Assessor of this problem with acreage and can adjust that number in the tax roll to more accurately reflect the correct area of 3.8 acres.

I am also sending a copy of my map to "Forest County Survey records" at the Courthouse. Please give me a call if you have any question or need further assistance with this matter. Thanks for contacting me to do this work!
