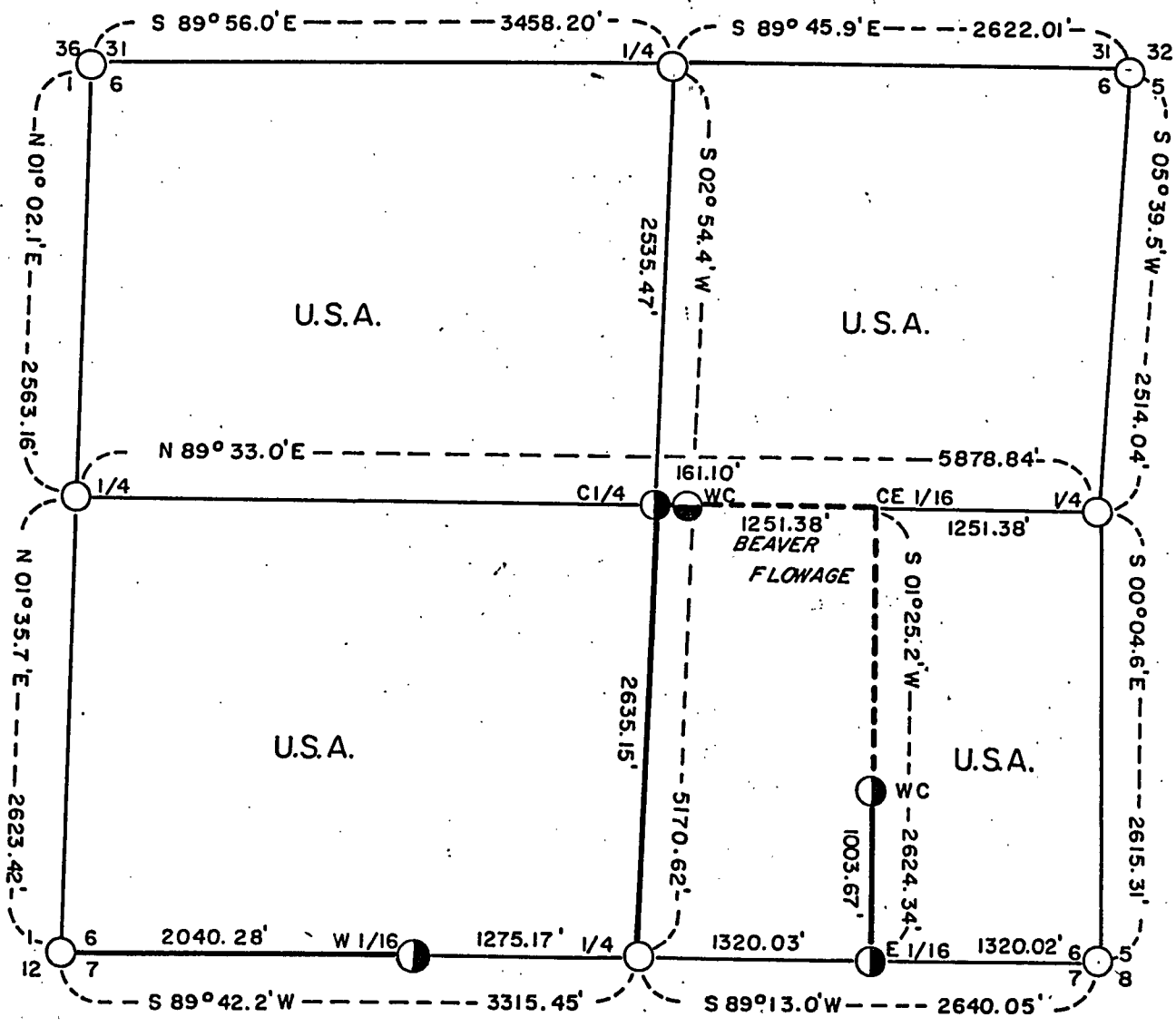


PLAT OF SURVEY U.S. GOVERNMENT LAND

SURVEY NOTES

This survey was made by AARON ASSOCIATES of Oconto Falls, Wisconsin under contract with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, using Forest Service section subdivisional data for the purpose of establishing subdivisional corners within Section 6, and for locating and marking the boundaries of U.S. Government lands on their perimeter and within Section 6, Township 34 North, Range 16 East, 4th Principal Meridian, Forest County, Wisconsin.

The U.S. Government lands were acquired in 1934-1935-1964.

The Original Government Survey of this township was made in 1859.

The corner positions recovered, restored and established by this survey are marked with monuments described in the map legend.

The corner positions established by this survey were located to an accuracy of one part in 3000.

The bearings between corner positions are True Bearings as determined by Solar observations.

The field notes of this survey and a copy of the plat map are on file in the Forest Supervisor's Office at Rhinelander, Wisconsin.

CORNERS RECOVERED AND RESTORED

1. Section Corner to Sections 36-31-6-1 of T35N, R15E; T35N, R16E; T34N, R15E; and T34N, R16E Respectively.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.

2. Section Corner to Sections 31-32, T35N, R16E, and 5-6, T34N, R16E.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.
3. Section Corner to Sections 5 -6 - 7-8, T34N, R16E.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.
4. Section Corner to Sections 6 -7, T34N, R16E and 11-12, T34N, R15E.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.
5. Quarter Corner to Sections 6-31, T34N, R16E, T35N, R16E. Respectively.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.
6. Quarter Corner to Sections 5 -6, T34N, R16E.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.
7. Quarter Corner to Sections 6 - 7, T34N, R16E.
Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.

8. Quarter Corner to Sections 1-6, T34N, R15E and T34N, R16E Respectively.

Corner position found marked with a Forest Service monument.
Certificate on file in the Forest County courthouse.

CORNERS ESTABLISHED9. West Sixteenth Corner between Sections 6-7, T34N, R16E.

Set this corner position at single proportionate position along the north line of Section 7 as determined by the Forest Service.

10. East Sixteenth Corner between Sections 6-7, T34N, R16E.

Set this corner position at midpoint between the south quarter and southeast corners of Section 6 as determined by the Forest Service.

11. Center Quarter Corner of Section 6, T34N, R16E.

Set this corner position at the straight line intersection of quarter lines in Section 6 as determined by the Forest Service.

12. Center-East Sixteenth Corner of Section 6, T34N, R16E.

This corner position was determined at the midpoint of the east-west quarter line of Section 6 between the center and east quarter corners. This corner fell in a beaver flowage which was inaccessible and Witness Corners were set to the west and south of this position as follows:

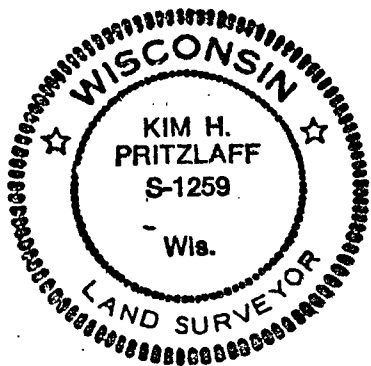
