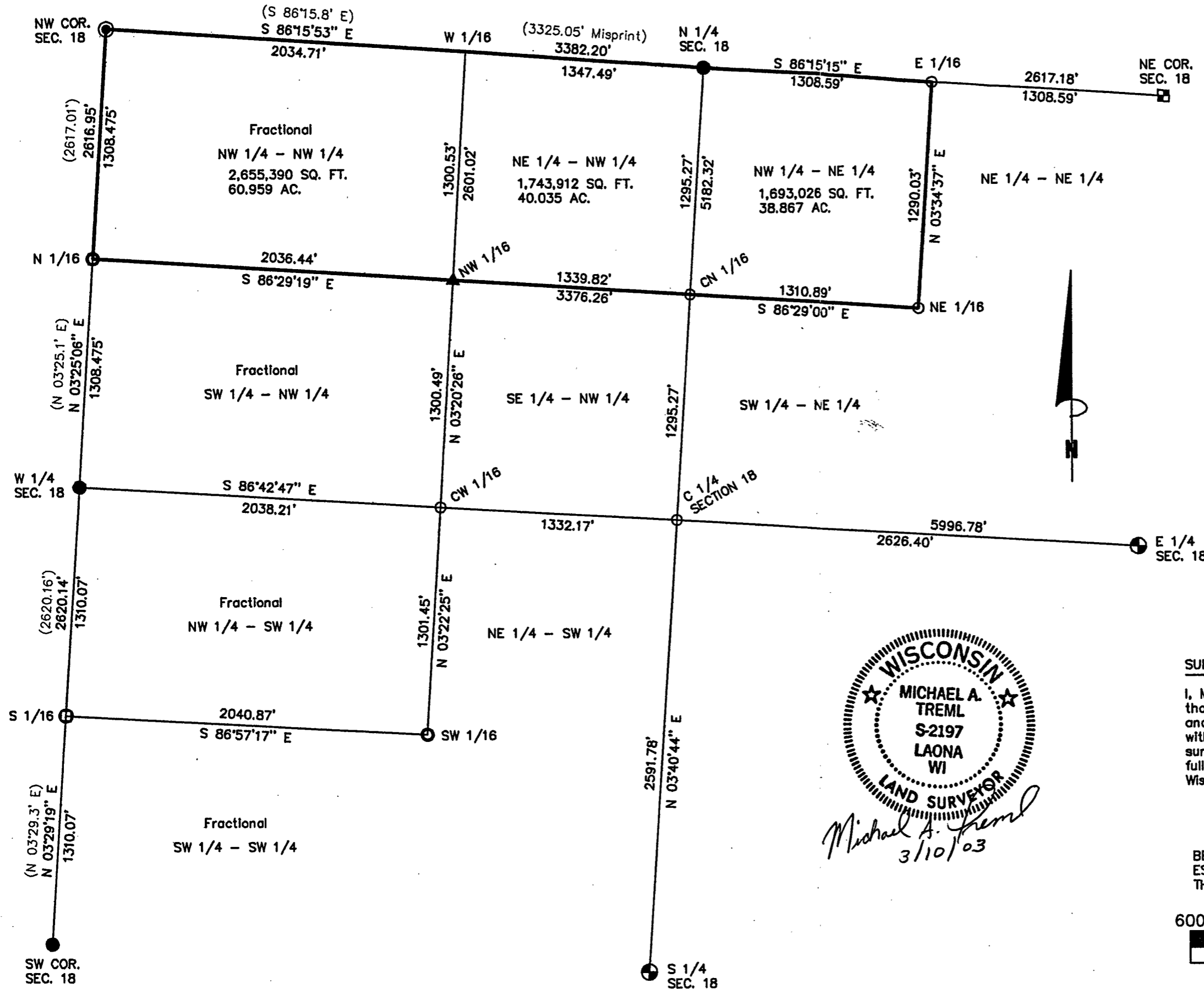


PLAT OF SURVEY

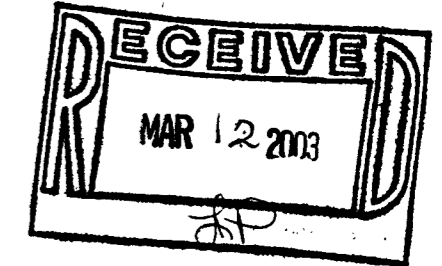
THE NW 1/4 - NE 1/4, THE NE 1/4 - NW 1/4
